We have registered to join a scheme called “The Bulb Man”. Along with this newsletter you will find catalogues for purchasing spring flowering bulbs.

For every £11.75 of bulbs ordered the school will receive £3.33. The school will also receive 150 free bulbs, though we must have a minimum order of £100.00. We hope to raise £150.00 for playground improvements and for this we will need to sell £530.00 worth of bulbs.

Please let friends and neighbours know now that they can purchase their bulbs through us, help the school **and** have their bulbs delivered rather than having to shop for them.

Please:

- Study the catalogue and chose your bulbs.
- Hand out catalogues to friends and neighbours - Extra catalogues are available from the school office and Jan Fawcett.
- Complete the order form on the back of the catalogue and make cheques payable to Church Preen PTA.
- The forms along with cheques (or cash in a strong sealed envelope) should be handed into school as soon as possible, marked “PTA Bulb scheme”.

The bulbs will be delivered to us on 11th October 2007 and handed out as soon as possible, in good time for planting in the garden.
