Help with music lesson costs available

Is your child aged 7-11 and keen to take part in musical activities but the costs are too much to manage?

- If you are in receipt of benefits (including Child Tax Credits) and are on a low income, or have exceptional circumstances, the Jon Hayward Memorial Trust may be able to help.
- The Trust has been providing financial assistance to eligible children in the Shropshire Council area since 2008.
- We award bursaries on an annual basis to part-fund (up to 50%) the cost of music lessons for a number of children, who have an interest in and aptitude for music, but are prevented from pursuing this due to their family's financial situation and the lack of funding from elsewhere.
- Our support can be for lessons in school, or arranged privately.
- We also have a number of instruments (violins and guitars) which we are able to loan to interested families free-of-charge (provided the instruments are returned in good condition.)



Family and friends, with the support of numerous musicians, have been fundraising since 2007 in order to enable children, who might not otherwise get the opportunity, to access music.








