# Cound Class

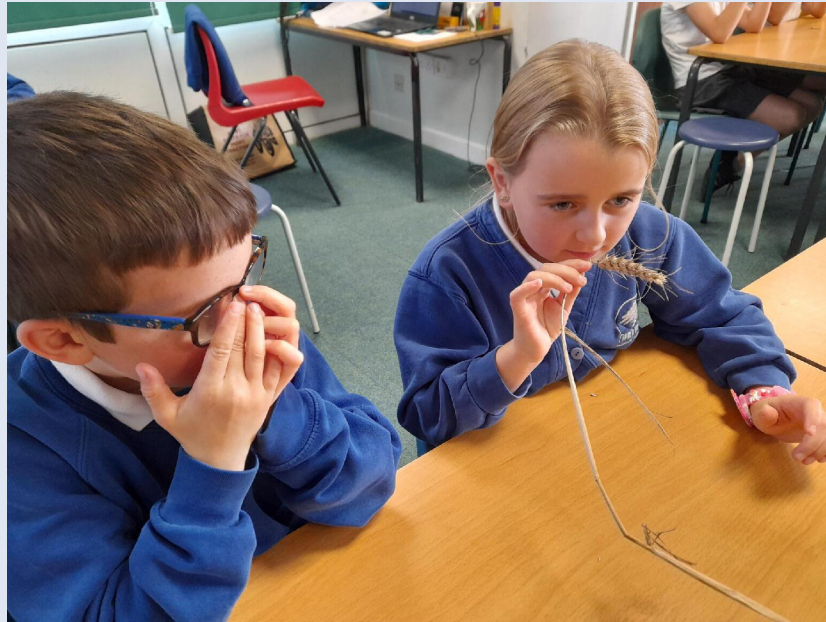

Dear Parents,

Welcome to the new academic year in Class Severn. The children have all settled in beautifully to the class, helping create the calm, kind, respectful atmosphere for great learning to happen!

This term, our Geography unit on Eastern Europe has kicked off a year with great start. We've learned our continents, countries and capitals of Europe, and look forward to researching countries in more detail. In DT, we've explored bread production and types of bread around the world. We can't wait to design and make our own Eastern European inspired bread later this half term. In English, we've been developing our writing skills by looking at the text *The Lion and the Unicorn* by Shirley Hughes – a powerful story about a child evacuee from WW2.
