



As part of our Science studies, Year 1 and 2 spent a morning in our fabulous Forest School thinking about how they could encourage more wildlife to the area. They chose a woodland animal and focused on a part of the site they wanted to improve, They came up with some wonderful ideas which included a bird feeding station, wormery, pond, squirrel feeders, homes for newts, woodlice and hedgehogs, and a place for caterpillars to thrive. Back in class, they drew their ideas and eloquently explained the reasons behind their decisions. We hope to turn some of these ideas into a reality in the new year.

Dear Parents,

What a fantastic half term we've had in Class Severn. The children's writing has come on leaps and bounds; shown in their European persuasive leaflets and Anne Frank Biography. We've enjoyed creating some brilliant charcoal artworks inspired by the poems Tiger Tiger (Y3/4) and The Jabberwocky (Y5/6). Our Science unit on electricity has developed our knowledge of circuits, and conductors and insulators. Look out for our final project – an LED Christmas card!

I am also very excited to announce a new initiative with Shropshire Good Food Partnership. Undertaken as part of the SGFP's Schools Food Web project supported by Let's Go Zero Fund, the overall objective is to drive food system education, learning and practical skills leading to decarbonisation in Church Preen Primary School through a climate-friendly food system. As a school, we will enrich our bespoke Science, Design & Technology, and Outdoor Learning Curriculum through the initiative. Over the coming year, pupils will take part in a series of workshops teaching them about composting (one held earlier this term with Garden Organic), importance of nutrition, and practical activities growing and cooking with produce grown in our school garden. We will also be working with our kitchen to extend the impact of the project across the school, and work towards the goal of reducing our carbon footprint. We were delighted to accept as part of the initiative a £1000 grant from Shropshire Good Food Partnership. Using the pupils' ideas, we will be using this grant to improve our facilities, and equipment available, for your child/ren to achieve out decarbonisation goals. Look out for updates soon!


