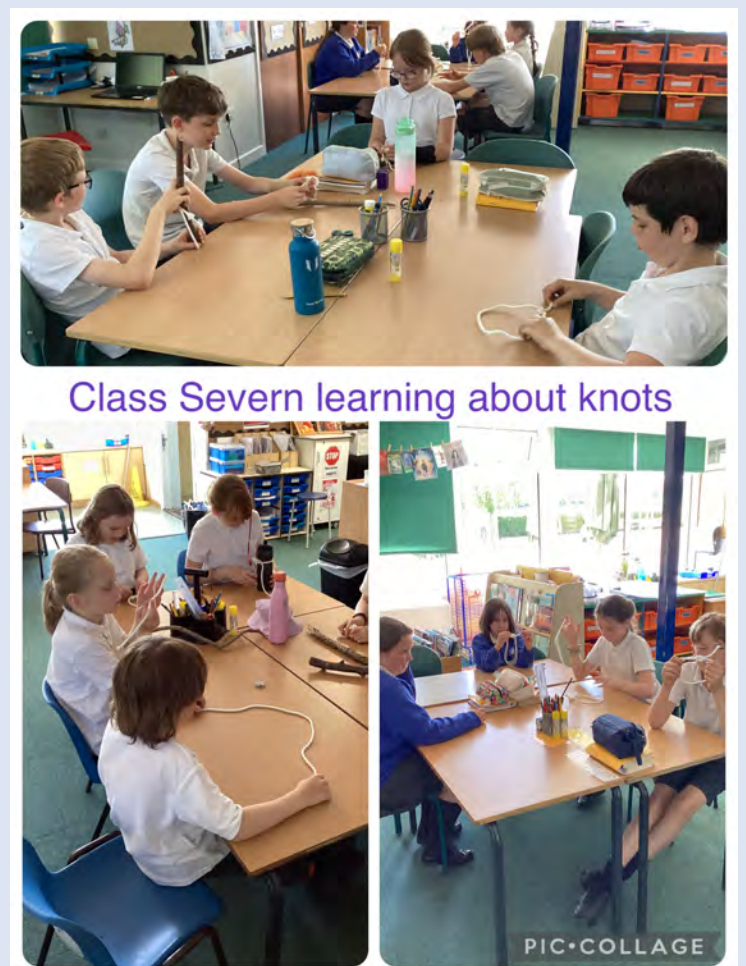
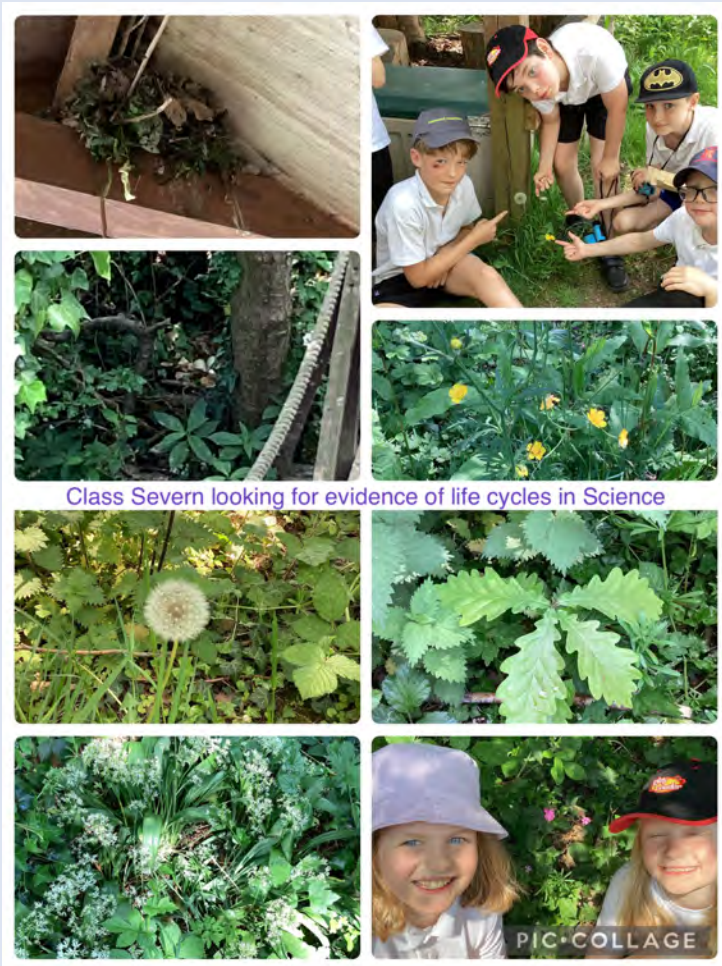
As part of our progressive outdoor skills curriculum, Year 1 and 2 used flints and steels to make fire.

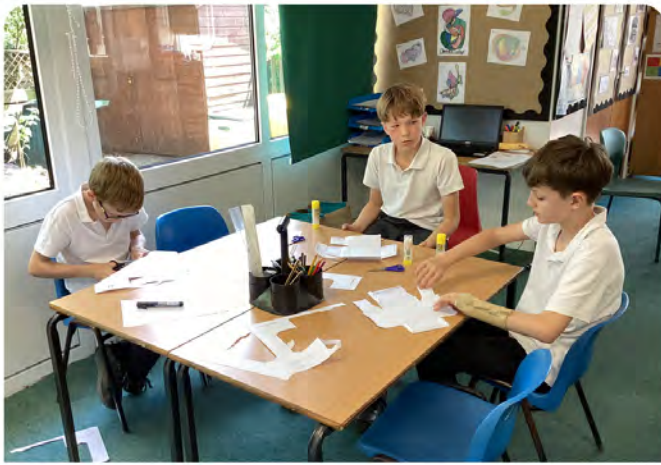
Perseverance paid off. Well done everyone.

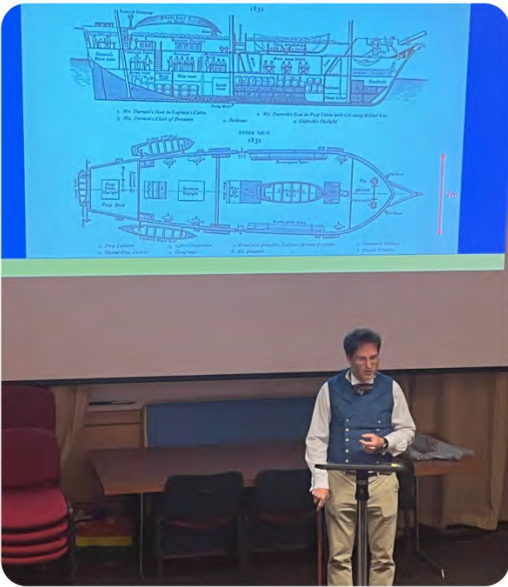

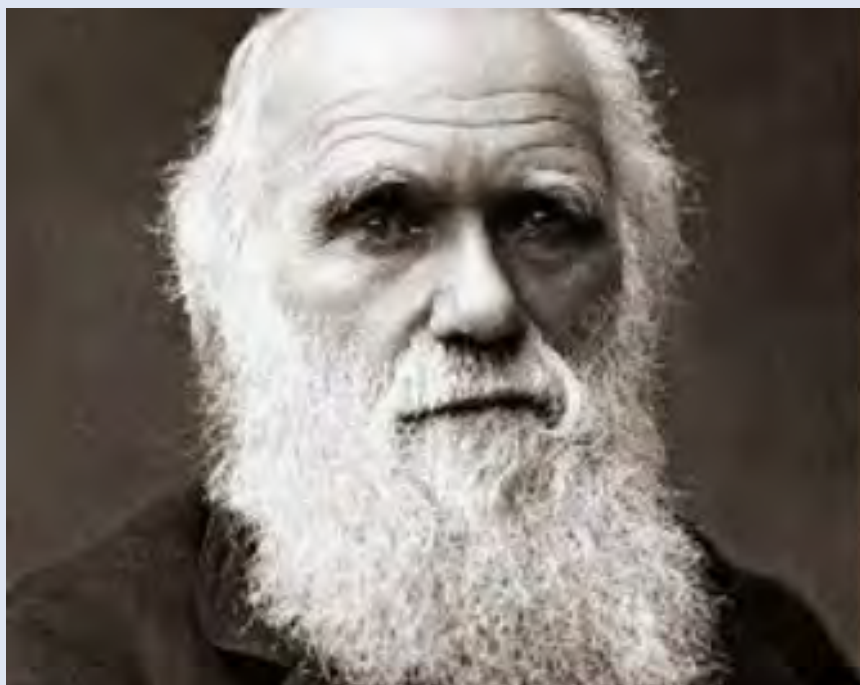

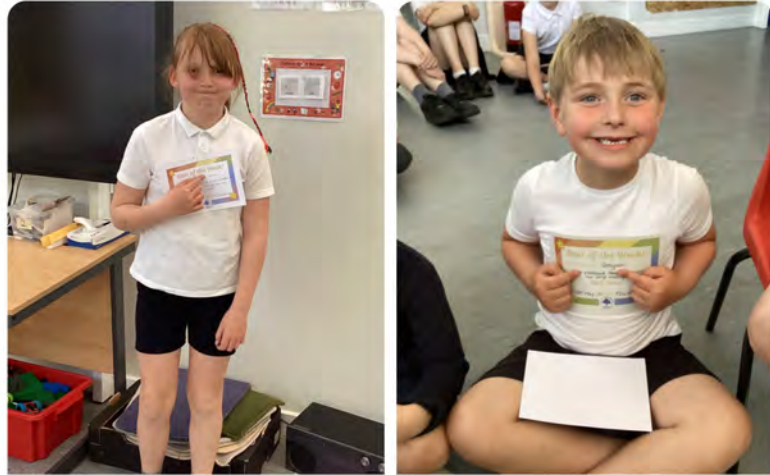
