 <p><b><u>Options</u></b>            Can you think of two very different activities that a visitor might enjoy doing in Shropshire? Think about its geographical features (rivers, lakes, hills, forests) and historic towns or buildings.</p>	
 <p><b>Overview:</b>            Can you think of anything else that makes Shropshire so special or famous?            Where is Shropshire in the UK?</p>	

 <u>Weather and Climate</u> What is the weather like in Shropshire? When is the best time to visit?	
 <u>Food and Farming</u> What food is grown locally? Are there any famous dishes associated with Shropshire? Do you have a favourite place where you like to eat out?	
 <u>Sight-seeing</u> Are there any museums, castles, historic monuments, zoos or safari parks that you like to visit? Try to think of 3 different places.	
<u>Adventurous activities</u>  Could they be water/air or land-based? Over-ground or under-ground?	

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
