

## © Key Instant Recall Facts <br> Year 5 - Summer Term I

By the end of this half term, children should know the following facts. The aim is for them to recall these facts with speed and accuracy:

## I know the first five cube numbers

Children should know that a cube number is any number multiplied by itself three times.
$n \times n \times n$.
It can be written as $n^{3}$

The first five cube numbers are:
$|x| x \mid=1$
$2 \times 2 \times 2=8$
$3 \times 3 \times 3=27$
$4 \times 4 \times 4=64$
$5 \times 5 \times 5=125$
